Director's Report



CCA Information

A new agreement has been reached between NALC and USPS; therefore, in 2018 City Carrier Assistants will no longer be eligible to receive the \$125 contribution toward their NALC Health Benefit Plan Self Plus One and Self and Family premiums.

A special enrollment period will be offered to City Carrier Assistants from September 4 to October 19, 2017. During this time, City Carrier Assistants will be eligible to enroll in or change their enrollment in the United States Postal Service Health Benefit Plan.

Keep in mind, there is a deadline to make this decision. If the change or enrollment is completed during the special enrollment period, the coverage will be effective on October 28, 2017. The next opportunity to make a change or enroll is during Open Season, which is November 13, 2017 – December 11, 2017. Elections made during Open Season will take effect January 6, 2018.

During the Special Enrollment Period, you may use PostalEASE employee self-service to enroll in the USPS Health Benefit Plan or change your enrollment. If you are unable to use PostalEASE, you may complete the PostalEASE Worksheet (available on LiteBlue) and mail it to the HR Shared Service Center at:

Immunizations

How Vaccines Prevent Disease

The diseases that vaccines prevent can be dangerous, or even deadly. Vaccines reduce the risk of infection by working with the body's natural defenses to help it safely develop immunity to disease.

When germs, such as bacteria or viruses, invade the body, they attack and multiply. This invasion is called an infection, and the infection is what causes illness. The immune system then has to fight the infection. Once it fights off the infection, the body is left with a supply of cells that help recognize and fight that disease in the future.

Vaccines help develop immunity by imitating an infection, but this "imitation" infection does not cause illness. It does, however, cause the immune system to develop the same response as it does to a real infection so the body can recognize and fight the vaccine-preventable disease in the future. Sometimes, after getting a vaccine, the imitation infection can cause minor symptoms, such as fever. Such minor symptoms are normal and should be expected as the body builds immunity.

As children get older, they require additional doses of some vaccines for best protection. Older kids also need to be protected against additional diseases they may encounter.

Vaccines and Your Child's Immune System

As a parent, you may get upset or concerned when you watch your baby get 3 or 4 shots during a doctor's visit. But, all of those shots add up to your baby being protected against 14 infectious diseases. Young babies can get very ill from vaccine-preventable diseases. The vaccination schedule is designed to protect young children before they are likely to be exposed to potentially serious diseases and when they are most vulnerable to serious infections.

Although children continue to get several vaccines up to their second birthday, these vaccines do not overload the immune system. Every day, your healthy baby's immune system successfully fights off thousands of antigens-the parts of germs that cause the body's immune system to respond. The antigens in vaccines come from weakened or killed germs so they cannot cause serious illness. Vaccines contain only a tiny amount of the antigens that your baby encounters every day, even if your child receives several vaccines in one day.

Combination vaccines take two or more vaccines that could be given individually and put them into one shot. Children get the same protection as they do from individual vaccines given separately—but with fewer shots.

My Disney Experience & Online Check-In Service

I want to inform you about the My Disney Experience tab on the **Disneyworld.com** website. Once you register online, there are a multitude of tools available that will really enhance your trip. You can also download the mobile app "My Disney Experience" to access your plans and park information on the go. You may also use the My Disney Experience site to participate in the Online Check-In Service. Your guests may shorten their check in process by logging into the following link: **https://disneyworld.disney.go.com/plan/** within 60 days of their arrival date. When they arrive at their hotel, they will simply need to show a photo ID at the designated online check-in area.

Disney's Magical Express - Deadline 10 Days Prior to Arrival

Disney's Magical Express (DME) is a complimentary airport service between guests staying at a Walt Disney World Owned and Operated Resort Hotels and the Orlando International Airport.

DME also includes complimentary luggage delivery service to the guest room for flights that arrive between 5:00 AM and 10:00 PM. Guests arriving after 10:00 PM on either a scheduled or delayed flight will need to claim their luggage and bring it with them on the motorcoach.

Advanced reservations are required to use Disney's Magical Express.

How do you book a DME reservation? You may go online to https://disneyworld.disney.go.com or call (407) 939-4686 to reserve Disney's Magical Express. **NOTE:** room reservations need to be made before a DME reservation can be made.

Prior to arrival at Orlando International Airport

Pre-tagged luggage (United States and Canada). For guests in the United States and Canada, approximately one week prior to departure for Orlando your Disney's Magical Express (DME) booklet with 1 luggage tag per person should arrive at the address provided. The DME luggage tag should be placed on the luggage bag that will be checked at the airport.

NOTE: reservations made less than 10 days prior to arrival will not receive a DME booklet. The guests should collect their own luggage and proceed to the Disney Welcome Center located on the B Side on Level 1.
