- Flexible sigmoidoscopy up to every 5 years (or IO with yearly FIT)
- Computerized tomography (CT) colonography (virtual colonoscopy) – up to every 5 years

If you prefer a less invasive, more private approach to screening and are at average risk – consider at–home tests as a highly accurate alternative.

- FIT Immunochemical fecal occult blood test (stool blood test) – yearly
- DNA-FIT Immunochemical fecal occult blood test (stool DNA test) – every 3 years
