#### **Director's Report**



#### **NALC Constitution**

The NALC Health Benefit Plan is in the process of updating our records. Early this year we included a copy of the *Who is Your HBR?* form in the newsletter. Thank you for taking the time to complete the form and send it back to us. Through this process it was brought to our attention that some branches are not following the laws of the NALC Constitution. We will be sending out letters in the coming weeks to correct the issues and clean up all records.

The first oversight concerns the number of members in your branch. If the branch has more than 10 active members, the Branch Presdient may not hold another office. Per the NALC Constitution (page 69) Article 4. Sec. 1. The officers of the branch shall include a Health Benefits Representative. Sec. 2. All officers shall be elected for a term of one, two or three years. Sec. 3. With the exception of the office of President, Branches may consolidate the offices of the Branch. However, if there are less than ten (10) active members, the office of the President may be combined with other offices.

The second concern is the HBR has to be a member of the NALC Health Benefit Plan. Per the Constitution of The National Association of Letter Carriers Health Benefit Plan (page 132) Article 4. Sec. 3. No one shall hold any office in the National Health Benefit Plan of the National Association of Letter Carriers at any level, National, State Association, Regional, District, or Branch level, who is not a participating member of the National Association of Letter Carriers Health Benefit Plan.

We appreciate your assistance in correcting these errors so that we are all compliant with the NALC Constitution. We recently updated the *Who is Your HBR?* form and included it for your convenience. If you recently sent us an updated form there is no need to fill it out again but please use this version going forward for any updates.



#### **Mental Health Awareness**



#### What is Stigma? Why is it a Problem?

Stigma is when someone, or even you yourself, views a person in a negative way just because they have a mental health condition. Some people describe stigma as a feeling of shame or judgement from someone else. Stigma can even come from an internal place, confusing feeling bad with being bad.

Navigating life with a mental health condition can be tough, and the isolation, blame and secrecy that is often encouraged by stigma can create huge challenges to reaching out, getting needed support and living well. Learning how to avoid and address stigma are important for all of us, especially when you realize stigma's effects:

- People experiencing mental health conditions often face rejection, bullying and discrimination. This can make their journey to recovery longer and more difficult.
- Mental health conditions are the leading cause of disability across the United States.
- Even though most people can be successfully treated, less than half of the adults in the U.S. who need services and treatment get the help they need.
- The average delay between the onset of symptoms and intervention is 8-10 years.
- Suicide is the second leading cause of death of youth ages 15-24 and the tenth leading cause of death for all Americans.

Stigma is toxic to mental health because it creates an environment of shame, fear and silence that prevents many people from seeking help and treatment.

# The National Alliance on Mental Illness (NAMI's) Three Steps for Being StigmaFree:

- 1. Educate yourself and others Everyone knows a little about mental health issues but knowing the facts can help you educate others and reject stigmatizing stereotypes.
- 2. See the person, not the condition 1 in 5 Americans live with a mental health condition and each of them has their own story, path and journey that says more about them than their diagnosis does.
- 3. Take Action We can take action now as we push for better legislation and policies to improve lives for everyone. By lending your support, you can show that this cause is important to you.
